A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act authorizing advisory votes by the qualified
7 voters of the state on a state income tax on indi-
8 viduals."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. The lieutenant governor shall place before the qualified
11 voters of the state at the next general election the following question,
12 advisory to the legislature. The question shall appear on the ballot in
13 substantially the following form:

16 uals. In light of declining oil revenue, the legisla-
17 ture is considering reenacting the income tax on indi-
18 viduals in order to meet the financial needs of the
19 state. Should the legislature enact an income tax
