A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to absences from the state for
7 medical treatment for purposes of disqualification
8 for a longevity bonus; and providing for an effective
9 date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 47.45.030 is amended by adding new subsections to read:

12 (b) Notwithstanding (a) of this section, upon application by a
13 recipient in accordance with regulations of the commissioner of admin-
14 istration, the commissioner may find that the recipient is not dis-
15 qualified from receiving a bonus during or after an absence from the
16 state if the

17 (1) primary reason for the absence is to obtain necessary
18 medical treatment for a serious condition; and

19 (2) medical treatment is not available in the state or not
20 practical for the recipient to obtain in the state.

21 (c) A recipient who receives a bonus under (b) of this section,
22 shall supply information regarding the recipient's medical condition
23 and treatment on a periodic basis as required by the Department of
24 Administration.

25 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect September 30, 1986.
