6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Alaska vocational education
7 equipment grant fund; and providing for an effective
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 14.35.025(5) is amended to read:

11 (5) designate the districts, schools, departments, or
12 programs [CLASSES] to participate in the benefits of money received
13 according to the Act.

14 * Sec. 2. AS 14.35 is amended by adding a new section to read:

15 Sec. 14.35.050. ALASKA VOCATIONAL EDUCATION EQUIPMENT GRANT
16 FUND. (a) There is established the vocational education equipment
17 grant fund as an account in the general fund. The fund is to be used
18 to provide vocational education equipment grants to school districts
19 for

20 (1) acquisition of major vocational education equipment for
21 a new vocational program that has been approved by the department;

22 (2) acquisition of major vocational education equipment for
23 a vocational program that has been approved by the department, where
24 advances in technology have made existing equipment obsolete; and

25 (3) acquisition or repair of major vocational education
26 equipment when existing equipment is not operational but is not due
27 for scheduled replacement.

28 (b) Grants from the fund may be used only for the acquisition of
29 vocational equipment that costs more than \$2,000, and must be made on

1 forms provided by the department.

2 (c) The department shall adopt necessary regulations to imple-
3 ment this section.

4 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 1986.
