8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
9 * Section 1. AS 28.15.041 is amended by adding a new subsection to
10 read:
11 (d) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a person may not
12 drive a pilot car unless the person has a valid Alaska driver's li-
13 cense in the possession of the person. The operator of a pilot car
14 must be at least 19 years of age, and have held a valid driver's
15 license at least one year. In this subsection, "pilot car" means a
16 motor vehicle used as an extension of the warning system of an over-
17 sized motor vehicle with or without a load, or of a motor vehicle
18 carrying a permitted oversized load.
