6 For an Act entitled: "An Act designating the woolly mammoth as the state
7 fossil."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. By designating the woolly mammoth as
10 the state fossil, the legislature intends to give recognition to this
11 animal that was the largest and one of the most prevalent animals in the
12 state but whose remains are now found only as fossils.

13 * Sec. 2. AS 44.09 is amended by adding a new section to read:

14 Sec. 44.09.120. STATE FOSSIL. The woolly mammoth is the offi-
15 cial state fossil.
