6 For an Act entitled: "An Act designating the woolly mammoth (Mammuthus
7 primigenius) as the state fossil."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. By designating the woolly mammoth
10 (Mammuthus primigenius) as the state fossil, the legislature intends to
11 give recognition to this animal that was the largest and one of the most
12 prevalent animals in the state but whose remains are now found only as
13 fossils.

14 * Sec. 2. AS 44.09 is amended by adding a new section to read:

15 Sec. 44.09.120. STATE FOSSIL. The woolly mammoth (Mammuthus
16 primigenius) is the official state fossil.
