* Section 1. Rule 17 of the Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legisla-

RULE 17. DAILY ORDER OF BUSINESS. Unless changed by a two-

thirds vote of the full membership of the house the daily order of

business of each house is as follows:

(1) roll call;

(2) invocation or meditation;

(3) Pledge of Allegiance;

(4) [(3)] certification by the chief clerk or secretary to

the house as to the correctness of the journal of the previous day,

20

journal approved or ordered changed;

21

(5) [(4)] introduction of guests;

22

(6) [(5)] messages from the governor;

23

(7) [(6)] messages from the other house;

24

(8) [(7)] communications;

25

(9) [(8)] reports of standing committees;

26

(10) [(9)] reports of special committees;

27

(11) [(10)] introduction of resolutions;

28

(12) [(11)] introduction, first reading and reference of

29

bills;

- 1 (13) [(12)] consideration of daily calendar;
2 (A) second reading of bills of house;
3 (B) second reading of bills of other house;
4 (C) third reading of bills of house;
5 (D) third reading of bills of other house;
6 (E) all other matters up for final action in the
7 house;
8 (14) [(13)] unfinished business;
9 (15) [(14)] announcement of committee meetings;
10 (16) [(15)] special orders (not set for a particular hour);
11 (17) [(16)] adjournment.
