7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the Alaska State Legislature has expressed its continued
9 commitment to solving the state's unemployment problem through committee
10 work on Alaska hire during the 1986 legislative session; and

11 WHEREAS the legislature recognizes that legislation enacted this
12 session is only the beginning in effectively addressing the state's respon-
13 sibility to reduce unemployment among its residents; and

14 WHEREAS the Alaska State Legislature is committed to bringing Alaskans
15 and industry together in order to explore all avenues that can result in
16 the state maximizing the potential of its residents and its resources;

17 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that under Uniform Rule
18 21 a Joint Special Committee on Alaska Hire is established consisting of
19 four members of the Senate appointed by the President of the Senate and
20 four members of the House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker of
21 the House to examine Alaska hire; and be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee, when constituted, be directed to
23 involve Alaskans throughout the state and from all affected industries in
24 developing recommendations for implementing Alaska hire; and be it

25 FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee is authorized to meet during and
26 between sessions of the legislature and is to report its recommendations
27 and findings on the first day of the First Session of the Fifteenth Alaska
28 State Legislature and is terminated on the first day of the First Session
29 of the Fifteenth Alaska State Legislature.
