BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. Article I, sec. 19, Constitution of the State of Alaska,

is amended to read:

SECTION 19. RIGHT TO KEEP AND BEAR ARMS. The [A WELL-REGULATED

13

MILITIA BEING NECESSARY TO THE SECURITY OF A FREE STATE, THE] right of

14

each citizen of the state [THE PEOPLE] to keep and bear arms for

15

personal defense and for the defense of family, property, and the

16

state and for lawful hunting, recreation, and other lawful purposes,

17

shall not be infringed by the state or by a borough or city of the

18

state.

* Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed

20

before the voters of the state at the next general election in conformity

21

with art. XIII, sec. 1, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the elec-

tion laws of the state.
