Licensing Procedures.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

8 WHEREAS Alaska's statutes now contain numerous licensing requirements;

9 and

10 WHEREAS the various statutes are not uniform with respect to licensing
11 procedures and contain complicated and inconvenient requirements for
12 obtaining licenses; and

13 WHEREAS due to reduced state revenue it is now critically important
14 for state government to operate as efficiently as possible;

15 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate that

16 (1) there be established by the Senate a Select Committee on
17 State Licensing Procedures charged with the responsibility of reviewing
18 state licensing procedures and requirements, and reporting its recommenda-
19 tions for streamlining licensing procedures to the Senate no later than
20 January 19, 1987;

21 (2) the committee shall consist of three members of the Senate
22 appointed by the President of the Senate;

23 (3) to the greatest possible extent, the committee shall use
24 existing legislative staff and office space;

25 (4) expenses of the committee may be paid from any funds avail-
26 able to the leadership of the Senate;

27 (5) the committee may meet during the Second Session of the
28 Fourteenth Legislature and between sessions;

29 (6) the committee terminates January 19, 1987.
