6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to medical expenses of prisoners."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 43.23.065(b) is amended to read:

9 (b) An exemption is not available under this section for perma-  
10 nent fund dividends taken to satisfy

11 (1) child support obligations required by court order or  
12 decision of the child support enforcement agency under AS 47.23.140 -  
13 47.23.220;

14 (2) court ordered restitution under AS 12.55.045 - 12.55.-  
15 051 or 12.55.100;

16 (3) a court ordered probation fee under AS 12.55.105; [OR]

17 (4) a debt owed by an eligible individual to an agency of  
18 the state, unless the debt is contested and an appeal is pending, or  
19 the time limit for filing an appeal has not expired; or

20 (5) a debt owed by a prisoner for medical expenses under  
21 AS 33.30.015.

22 \* Sec. 2. AS 33.30 is amended by adding a new section to read:

23 Sec. 33.30.015. MEDICAL EXPENSES OF PRISONERS. The commissioner  
24 may attach the permanent fund dividend check of a prisoner who is in a  
25 correctional facility or committed by a court to the custody of the  
26 commissioner in order to pay the prisoner's medical expenses. Prop-  
27 erty other than a permanent fund dividend check may not be taken to  
28 pay a prisoner's medical expenses.
