BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 12.30.060 is amended by adding a new subsection to

(b) After entry of a judgment of forfeiture, the surety may

apply to the court for a remission. If it appears that justice does

13

not require the forfeiture, the court may grant the application and

14

remit forfeiture, in whole or in part. The court may impose condi-

15

tions of remission, including payment of the expenses incurred in the

16

proceedings for the enforcement of the forfeiture and in securing the

17

return of the defendant.
