6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to computation of good time during  
7 imprisonment."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 33.20.010 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 33.20.010. COMPUTATION OF GOOD TIME. (a) Except as provid-  
11 ed in (b) of this section and notwithstanding AS 12.55.125(f)(3) and  
12 12.55.125(g)(3), a prisoner convicted of an offense against the state  
13 or a political subdivision of the state and sentenced to a term of  
14 imprisonment that exceeds three days is entitled to a deduction of  
15 one-third of the term of imprisonment served after conviction and  
16 imposition of sentence, rounded off to the nearest day if the prisoner  
17 follows the rules of the correctional facility in which the prisoner  
18 is confined.

19 (b) A prisoner sentenced to a term of imprisonment of more than  
20 one year before April 9, 1986, who was entitled to a deduction of less  
21 than one-third of the term of imprisonment is entitled to a deduction  
22 of one-third of the portion of the term of imprisonment served after  
23 conviction and imposition of sentence and remaining to be served as of  
24 April 9, 1986, unless the Board of Parole determines that, with rea-  
25 sonable probability, the prisoner will not live and remain at liberty  
26 without violating any laws.
