7 applicants for certification as teachers and adminis-

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 12.62.035(e) is amended to read:

11 (e) As used in this section

12 (1) "contributing to the delinquency of a minor" means a  
13 conviction for a violation or attempted violations of AS 11.51.130(a)-  
14 (1), (3), or (5); former AS 11.40.130; or the laws of another juris-  
15 diction if the offense would have been a crime in this state under  
16 AS 11.51.130(a)(1), (3), or (5) or former AS 11.40.130 if committed in  
17 the state;

18 (2) "interested person" means a corporation, company,  
19 partnership, firm, association, organization, business trust, or  
20 society, as well as a natural person, that employs or solicits the  
21 employment of a person to serve with or without compensation in a  
22 position in which the person has or would have supervisory or disci-  
23 plinary power over a minor; the Department of Education is an inter-  
24 ested person with respect to a request for records of a person seeking  
25 certification as a teacher or administrator;

26 (3) "sex crime" means a conviction for a violation or  
27 attempted violation of AS 11.41.410 - 11.41.470, AS 11.61.110(a)(7),  
28 or AS 11.66.100 - 11.66.130; former AS 11.15.120, 11.15.134, or  
29 11.15.160; former AS 11.40.080, 11.40.110, 11.40.130, or 11.40.200 -

1 11.40.420; or the laws of another jurisdiction if the offense would  
2 have been a crime in this state under one of the sections listed in  
3 this paragraph if committed in the state.
