6 For an Act entitled: "An Act establishing Martin Luther King, Jr., Day as
7 a legal holiday."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 44.12.010 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 44.12.010. LEGAL HOLIDAYS. The following days are legal
11 holidays: (1) the first of January, known as New Year's Day; (2) the
12 third Monday of January, known as Martin Luther King, Jr.'s, Birthday;
13 (3) [(2)] the 12th of February, known as Lincoln's Birthday; (4) [(3)]
14 the third Monday in February, known as Washington's Birthday; (5)
15 [(4)] the last Monday of March, known as Seward's Day; (6) [(5)] the
16 last Monday in May, known as Memorial Day; (7) [(6)] the fourth of
17 July, known as Independence Day; (8) [(7)] the first Monday in Septem-
18 ber, known as Labor Day; (9) [(8)] the eighteenth of October, known as
19 Alaska Day; (10) [(9)] the 11th of November, known as Veterans' day;
20 (11) [(10)] the fourth Thursday in November, known as Thanksgiving
21 Day; (12) [(11)] the 25th of December, known as Christmas Day; (13)
22 [(12)] every Sunday; (14) [(13)] every day designated by public pro-
23 clamation by the President of the United States or the governor of the
24 state as a legal holiday.
