A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to entry of persons under age 21 to
7 licensed premises."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 04.16.049(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) A person under the age of 21 years may not knowingly enter
11 or remain in premises licensed under this title unless

12 (1) accompanied by a parent or [,] guardian and the parent
13 or guardian is licensed under this title to sell or serve alcoholic
14 beverages for consumption only on the licensed premises [OR SPOUSE WHO
15 HAS ATTAINED THE AGE OF 21 YEARS];

16 (2) the person is at least 16 years of age, the premises
17 are designated by the board as a restaurant for the purposes of this
18 section, and the person enters and remains only for dining; [OR]

19 (3) the person is under the age of 16 years, is accompanied
20 by a person over the age of 21 years, the parent or guardian of the
21 underaged person consents, the premises are designated by the board as
22 a restaurant for the purposes of this section, and the person enters
23 and remains only for dining; or

24 (4) accompanied by a parent or guardian and the premises
25 are entered for the purpose of touring a bottling works, brewery,
26 winery, wholesale warehouse, or distillery.
