6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to certain contributions from perma-  
7 nent fund dividends; and providing for an effective  
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 44.21 is amended by adding a new section to read:

11 Sec. 44.21.272. PUBLIC BROADCASTING ACCOUNT. (a) There is  
12 created in the general fund a public broadcasting account. The  
13 Department of Revenue shall prepare the permanent fund dividend appli-  
14 cation to allow an applicant to designate that \$5 of the dividend be  
15 subtracted from the check and contributed to the public broadcasting  
16 account. Permanent fund dividend contributions shall be deposited in  
17 the account by the Department of Revenue. The Department of Revenue  
18 may use money in the account to pay administrative costs incurred  
19 under this section.

20 (b) The public broadcasting account shall be held in trust by  
21 the Department of Administration for distribution to the commission to  
22 be used to carry out the powers and duties of the commission.

23 \* Sec. 2. AS 44.27 is amended by adding a new section to read:

24 Sec. 44.27.057. ARTS ACCOUNT. (a) There is created in the  
25 general fund an arts account. The Department of Revenue shall prepare  
26 the permanent fund dividend application to allow an applicant to  
27 designate that \$5 of the dividend be subtracted from the check and  
28 contributed to the arts account. Permanent fund dividend contribu-  
29 tions shall be deposited in the account by the Department of Revenue.

1     **The Department of Revenue may use money in the account to pay adminis-**  
2     **trative costs incurred under this section.**

3             **(b) The arts account shall be held in trust by the Department of**  
4     **Administration for distribution to the Alaska State Council on the**  
5     **Arts to be used to carry out the powers and duties of the council.**
