6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to patronizing a prostitute."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 11.66 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 11.66.105. PATRONIZING A PROSTITUTE. (a) A person commits
10 the crime of patronizing a prostitute if the person

11

(1) pays or offers or agrees to pay another person a fee to
12 engage in sexual conduct; or

13

(2) enters or remains in a place of prostitution with the
14 intent to engage in sexual conduct other than as a prostitute.

15

(b) Patronizing a prostitute is a class B misdemeanor.
