A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act extending the time limitation for prosecution
7 for certain offenses committed against a minor."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 12.10.020(c) is amended to read:

10 (c) Even if the general time limitation has expired, a prose-
11 cution under AS 11.41.410 - 11.41.460, AS 11.66.110 - 11.66.130,
12 former AS 11.41.430, or former AS 11.51.130(a)(4), for an offense
13 committed against a person under the age of 16 may be commenced within
14 one year after the crime is reported to a peace officer or the person
15 reaches the age of 16, whichever occurs first. This subsection does
16 not extend the period of limitation by more than seven [FIVE] years.
