6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to reimbursement for travel expenses
7 for certain legislative employees."
8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
9 * Section 1. AS 24.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:
10 Sec. 24.10.220. TRAVEL EXPENSES FOR CERTAIN EMPLOYEES. (a) A
11 legislator, other than a legislator who represents the capital city,
12 may authorize reimbursement of actual travel expenses for one eligi-
13 ble legislative employee each session under this section. To be
14 eligible, an employee must reside in the district that the legislator
15 represents and be employed by the legislator at the time that the
16 request for reimbursement is made. The expenses eligible for reim-
17 bursement are the reasonable cost of travel from the hub nearest the
18 residence of the employee to the capital city and the cost of return
19 travel to the hub. The reimbursement may be for costs of air travel
20 or ground transportation.
21 (b) In this section, "hub" means Anchorage, Barrow, Bethel,
22 Cordova, Dillingham, Fairbanks, Haines, Ketchikan, Kodiak, Kotzebue,
23 Nome, Petersburg, Sitka, Skagway, Valdez, and Wrangell.
