6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to reimbursement for transportation
7 expenses for certain legislative employees."
8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
9 * Section 1. AS 24.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:
10 Sec. 24.10.220. TRANSPORTATION EXPENSES FOR CERTAIN EMPLOYEES.
11 A legislator, other than a legislator who represents the capital city,
12 may authorize reimbursement of actual transportation expenses for one
13 eligible legislative employee each session under this section. To be
14 eligible, an employee must reside in the district that the legislator
15 represents and be employed by the legislator at the time that the
16 request for reimbursement is made. In this section, an employee of a
17 legislator whose district includes part of the Municipality of
18 Anchorage or the City of Fairbanks is considered to reside in the
19 district that the legislator represents if the employee resides any-
20 where in the appropriate municipality or city. The expenses eligible
21 for reimbursement are the actual cost of one round trip for each
22 session from the residence of the employee to the capital city. The
23 reimbursement may be for transportation costs of air travel or ground
24 transportation. The reimbursement may not include costs of food or
25 lodgings.
