A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act permitting a person who is related to a  
7 legislator to be employed by the legislature."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 24.60.090(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) An [A SPOUSE OR AN] individual [OTHER THAN A SPOUSE] who is  
11 related to a member of the legislature may [NOT] be employed by the  
12 legislature or [IN THE HOUSE IN WHICH THE LEGISLATOR IS A MEMBER, BY]  
13 an agency of the legislature [ESTABLISHED UNDER AS 24.20, OR IN EITHER  
14 HOUSE DURING THE INTERIM BETWEEN SESSIONS]. An individual who is  
15 related to an employee of the legislature may not be employed in a  
16 position over which the employee has supervisory authority. In this  
17 subsection, "an individual who is related to" means a child, step-  
18 child, husband, wife, mother, father, sister, or brother.
