A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act establishing the supplementary education  
7 grant program."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. SUPPLEMENTARY EDUCATION GRANT PROGRAM. (a) The supple-  
10 mentary education grant program is established in the Department of Educa-  
11 tion to help offset adverse consequences to certain school districts re-  
12 sulting from changes in the public school foundation program (AS 14.17)  
13 that were effective after fiscal year 1986. If the department determines  
14 that reductions in funding as a result of changes to the foundation program  
15 that were effective after fiscal year 1986 might significantly reduce  
16 educational services in a particular public school, the department may make  
17 a grant to a school district to increase educational services in that  
18 school in accordance with a plan submitted by the school district.

19 (b) The supplementary education grant fund is established in the  
20 Department of Education consisting of money appropriated to the fund. The  
21 department may make grants under (a) of this section from money in the  
22 fund. Except as otherwise provided in an appropriation act, money in the  
23 fund that is unencumbered and unobligated lapses into the general fund  
24 July 1, 1991.

25 (c) The Department of Education may adopt regulations necessary to  
26 carry out the purposes of this section, including regulations establishing  
27 requirements for applications for supplementary education grants.

28 \* Sec. 2. This Act is repealed July 1, 1991.
