7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the twentieth annual Girls' State will be held June 5 - 12,
9 1988, at the University of Alaska, Interior/Western, in Fairbanks under the
10 sponsorship of the American Legion Auxiliary and cooperating organizations;
11 and

12 WHEREAS this outstanding annual program of the American Legion Auxil-
13 iary ranks high among the efforts of several Alaska organizations to bring
14 to the youth delegates an awareness of their future roles in state and
15 local government; and

16 WHEREAS this week-long youth citizen exercise of Girls' State is made
17 possible by an admirable combination of volunteer service and the free
18 enterprise of generous people and organizations without placing a financial
19 burden on government or on the taxpayer; and

20 WHEREAS it is consistent with these standards for the legislature to
21 encourage state and local legislators and other public officials and agen-
22 cies to volunteer their services and provide copies of state publications
23 and materials that form an important part of the program;

24 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature salutes the sponsors
25 of and participants in the twentieth annual Girls' State program; commends
26 those government officials and agencies and private individuals and orga-
27 nizations who support and participate in this exercise in youth citizen-
28 ship; and pledges to continue to provide legislative materials, advice, and
29 encouragement to the Girls' State program as it does to similar worthy
