BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. Rule 37(a) of the Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legis-

11

lature is amended to read:

(a) Any member, group of members, standing, special, or joint

13

committee may introduce a bill or resolution, subject to the pro-

14

visions of these Uniform Rules. A member may be designated as prime

15

sponsor or cosponsor of a measure introduced by a group and more than

16

one member may be designated as prime sponsor. A measure [BILL] must

17

be introduced, in proper form as approved by the enrolling secretary

18

of the legislature, with the original and two carbon copies delivered

19

to the chief clerk or secretary. The measure [BILL] is then assigned

20

a number which it retains through subsequent changes and substitu-

21

tions. The measure [BILL] is considered formally introduced when the

22

clerk or secretary reads the heading and title aloud in open session

23

(first reading). Measures [BILLS] may be introduced through the Rules

24

Committees by the governor and the permanent interim committees pursu-

25

ant to provisions of law.
