5 Proposing an amendment to Rule 37(a) of  
6 the Uniform Rules of the Alaska State  
7 Legislature relating to introduction of  
8 bills or resolutions.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. Rule 37(a) of the Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legis-  
11 lature is amended to read:

12 (a) Any member, group of members, standing, special, or joint  
13 committee may introduce a bill or resolution, subject to the pro-  
14 visions of these Uniform Rules. A member may be designated as prime  
15 sponsor or cosponsor of a measure and more than one member may be  
16 designated as prime sponsor. A measure [BILL] must be introduced, in  
17 proper form as approved by the enrolling secretary of the legislature,  
18 with the original and two carbon copies delivered to the chief clerk  
19 or secretary. The measure [BILL] is then assigned a number which it  
20 retains through subsequent changes and substitutions. The measure  
21 [BILL] is considered formally introduced when the clerk or secretary  
22 reads the heading and title aloud in open session (first reading).  
23 Measures [BILLS] may be introduced through the Rules Committees by the  
24 governor and the permanent interim committees pursuant to provisions  
25 of law.
