5 Proposing an amendment to the Constitu-
6 tion of the State of Alaska relating to
7 the legislative vote required to pass
8 certain tax bills.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. Article II, sec. 14, Constitution of the State of Alaska,
11 is amended to read:

12 SECTION 14. PASSAGE OF BILLS. The legislature shall establish
13 the procedure for enactment of bills into law. No bill may become law
14 unless it has passed three readings in each house on three separate
15 days, except that any bill may be advanced from second to third read-
16 ing on the same day by concurrence of three-fourths of the house
17 considering it. A bill may not become law without an affirmative vote
18 of a majority of the membership of each house. A bill that creates a
19 new tax or increases an existing tax may not become law without the
20 affirmative vote of two-thirds of the membership of each house. The
21 yeas and the nays on final passage shall be entered in the journal.
22 In this section, "tax" means a tax levied by the state on

23 (1) an individual's

24 (A) ownership, transfer, or use of real or personal
25 property; or

26 (B) income; or

27 (2) the retail sale of goods or services.

28 * Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed
29 before the voters of the state at the next general election in conformity

1 with art. XIII, sec. 1, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the elec-
2 tion laws of the state.
