6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the violation of compulsory  
7 education laws."  
8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:  
9 \* Section 1. AS 14.30.010(a) is amended to read:  
10 (a) Every child between seven and 16 years of age shall attend  
11 school at the public school in the district in which the child resides  
12 during each school term. Every parent, guardian or other person  
13 having the responsibility for or control of a child between seven and  
14 16 years of age shall maintain the child in attendance at a public  
15 school in the district in which the child resides during the entire  
16 school term, except as provided in (b) of this section [INSURE THAT  
17 THE CHILD IS NOT ABSENT FROM ATTENDANCE].  
18 \* Sec. 2. AS 14.30.020 is repealed and reenacted to read:  
19 Sec. 14.30.020. VIOLATIONS. A person who knowingly fails to  
20 comply with AS 14.30.010 is guilty of a violation. Each five days of  
21 unlawful absence under AS 14.30.010 is a separate violation.  
22 \* Sec. 3. AS 14.30.050 is repealed.
