6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to fingerprinting of minors; and

amending Alaska Rule of Children's Procedure 24."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 47.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 47.10.097. FINGERPRINTING OF ARRESTED MINORS. An arrested

11

minor who is 14 years of age or older shall be fingerprinted. An

12

arrested minor who is less than 14 years of age may not be finger-

13

printed unless court approval is obtained. The fingerprint records of

14

a minor are subject to AS 47.10.090.

* Sec. 2. AS 47.10.097 enacted in sec. 1 of this Act has the effect of

16

amending Alaska Rule of Children's Procedure 24, by allowing fingerprinting

17

without court order of minors in custody who are 14 years of age or older.
