5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act making supplemental appropriations to the  
7 Department of Education for pupil transportation,  
8 tuition students, multi-handicapped students, the  
9 Kotzebue Technical Center, and districts losing more  
10 than 10 percent of their foundation funding in a  
11 single year; and providing for an effective date."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

13 \* Section 1. The sum of \$3,341,000 is appropriated from the general  
14 fund to the Department of Education for pupil transportation during the  
15 fiscal year ending June 30, 1987.

16 \* Sec. 2. The sum of \$2,500,000 is appropriated from the general fund  
17 to the Department of Education for tuition students during the fiscal year  
18 ending June 30, 1987.

19 \* Sec. 3. The sum of \$430,000 is appropriated from the general fund to  
20 the Department of Education for payment under AS 14.17 for the Juneau  
21 multi-handicapped program for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1987.

22 \* Sec. 4. The sum of \$400,000 is appropriated from the general fund to  
23 the Department of Education for the Kotzebue Technical Center for supple-  
24 mental expenses during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1987.

25 \* Sec. 5. The sum of \$5,885,365 is appropriated from the general fund  
26 to the Department of Education for the purpose of holding harmless those  
27 school districts that would otherwise lose in excess of 10 percent of their  
28 foundation funding during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1987. Those
