A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to release of certain permanent fund
7 dividend and drivers' license information to the
8 United States Selective Service System."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 28.15.151 is amended by adding a new subsection to
11 read:

12 (g) From files maintained under this section, the department
13 shall release to the United States Selective Service System, if re-
14 quested, the name, address, date of birth, and social security number
15 of men required under federal law to register with the Selective
16 Service System. Information released under this section may not be
17 used for any purpose other than the enforcement of federal Selective
18 Service System registration laws. Applications required by the de-
19 partment under this chapter shall contain a statement that the appli-
20 cant is not required to supply a social security number, but if one is
21 provided, it will be given to the United States Selective Service
22 System to be used to enforce federal Selective Service System regis-
23 tration laws.

24 * Sec. 2. AS 43.05.230(a) is amended to read:

25 (a) It is unlawful for a current or former officer, employee, or
26 agent of the state to divulge the amount of income or the particulars
27 set out or disclosed in a report or return made under this title,
28 except

29 (1) in connection with official investigations or

1 proceedings of the department, whether judicial or administrative,
2 involving taxes due under this title;

3 (2) in connection with official investigations or proceed-
4 ings of the child support enforcement agency, whether judicial or
5 administrative, involving child support obligations imposed or im-
6 posable under AS 25 or AS 47;

7 (3) as provided in AS 38.05.036 pertaining to audit func-
8 tions; [AND]

9 (4) as provided in AS 43.23.017, pertaining to the release
10 of permanent fund dividend application information to the United
11 States Selective Service System; and

12 (5) as otherwise provided in this section.

13 * Sec. 3. AS 43.23 is amended by adding a new section to read:

14 Sec. 43.23.017. RELEASE OF INFORMATION TO SELECTIVE SERVICE
15 SYSTEM. From information provided on permanent fund dividend applica-
16 tions, the department shall release to the United States Selective
17 Service System, if requested, the name, address, date of birth, and
18 social security number of men required under federal law to register
19 with the Selective Service System. Information released under this
20 section may not be used for any purpose other than the enforcement of
21 federal Selective Service System registration laws. The permanent
22 fund dividend application shall contain a statement that the applicant
23 is not required to supply a social security number, but if one is
24 provided, it will be given to the United States Selective Service
25 System to be used to enforce federal Selective Service System regis-
26 tration laws.
