6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the membership of the agricul-
7 tural revolving loan fund board."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 03.10.050(b) is amended to read:

10 (b) The board is composed of seven [FIVE] members appointed by
11 the governor and confirmed by the legislature in joint session. Five
12 [THREE] members shall be persons with background and experience in
13 Alaska agriculture, two of whom shall be farmers who operate producing
14 farms in the state and who have operated producing farms in the state
15 for at least five years. Members of the board serve for overlapping
16 three-year terms. Members of the board are not entitled to receive
17 compensation for their services, but shall receive the same travel pay
18 and per diem as provided by law for boards and commissions.

19 * Sec. 2. INITIAL APPOINTMENTS. The governor shall appoint two persons
20 who operate producing farms in the state and who have operated producing
21 farms in the state for at least five years to fill the new positions
22 created on the agricultural revolving loan fund board by this Act. The
23 governor shall appoint one person to an initial term of three years and one
24 person to an initial term of two years to fill the new positions on the
25 board.
