6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to registration of vehicles owned by

Pearl Harbor survivors."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 28.10.181(1) is amended to read:

10

(1) Vehicles owned by Pearl Harbor survivors and former prison-

11

ers of war. The department, upon receipt of written proof, may issue

12

without charge special registration plates for one noncommercial motor

13

vehicle to a person who was on active military duty in Pearl Harbor on

14

December 7, 1941, or who has been a prisoner of war during a declared

15

war or other conflict, as determined by the Department of Defense

16

under federal regulations. The design and color of the Pearl Harbor

17

survivor or prisoner of war plates shall be solely within the dis-

18

cretion of the commissioner.
