6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Alaska Business License Act;
7 relating to release of information obtained under the
8 Act; and providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 43.05.230 is amended by adding a new subsection to
11 read:

12 (h) The department may release information received or collected
13 by the department under AS 43.70 that is related to the legal or
14 business names of licensees to the Department of Commerce and Economic
15 Development for use in carrying out the statutory responsibilities of
16 the Department of Commerce and Economic Development.

17 * Sec. 2. AS 43.70.020(a) is amended to read:

18 (a) For the privilege of engaging in a business in the state, a
19 person shall first apply, on [UPON] forms prescribed by the commis-
20 sioner of revenue, and obtain a license, and pay the license fee
21 provided for in AS 43.70.030. A license issued to a firm for a par-
22 ticular line of business covers all of the firm's [ITS] operations in
23 the state in the line of business regardless of the number of the
24 firm's [ITS] establishments. A license issued under this subsection
25 must [SHALL] include

- 26 (1) the name and address of the licensee;
27 (2) the line of business to be conducted; [AND]
28 (3) the year for which the license is issued; and
29 (4) the business name to be used by the licensee.

1 * Sec. 3. AS 43.70.020(b) is repealed and reenacted to read:

2 (b) A license issued under this section is valid for two years
3 after the date of issuance, except that if the licensee also holds a
4 license issued by the Department of Commerce and Economic Development
5 for an occupation listed in AS 08.01.010 or by a board listed in
6 AS 08.01.010, the license issued under this section is valid for the
7 same length of time as the license issued by the department or board.
8 To renew a license issued under this section, the licensee must apply
9 for renewal of the license and pay the renewal fee before the date the
10 license expires.

11 * Sec. 4. AS 43.70.030(a) is amended to read:

12 (a) The license fee for each business is \$25 for each year of
13 the period for which the license is issued. The renewal fee is the
14 same amount as the license fee.

15 * Sec. 5. AS 43.70.090 is amended to read:

16 Sec. 43.70.090. REGULATIONS. The department may adopt regula-
17 tions necessary to [DETERMINE AND] collect the fees imposed by this
18 chapter [AND MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS DEFINING THE NECESSARY METHODS OF
19 COMBINATION AND APPORTIONMENT FOR MULTISTATE FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS
20 REQUIRED TO FILE UNDER THIS CHAPTER].

21 * Sec. 6. AS 43.70.020(c), 43.70.030(d), 43.70.040(a), 43.70.110(2),
22 and 43.70.110(3) are repealed.

23 * Sec. 7. This Act takes effect January 1, 1988.
