6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to issuance or relocation of a club
7 license for the sale of alcoholic beverages."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 04.11.400(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) Except as provided in (g), (h), (i), and (j) of this sec-
11 tion, a new license may not be issued and the board may prohibit
12 relocation of an existing license

13 (1) outside an established village, incorporated city,
14 unified municipality, or organized borough if after the issuance or
15 relocation there would be more than one restaurant or eating place
16 license for each 1,500 population or fraction of 1,500 population or
17 more than one license of each other type, including licenses that have
18 been issued under (g) or (h) of this section, for each 3,000 popula-
19 tion or fraction of 3,000 population in a radius of five miles of the
20 licensed premises or location of premises sought to be licensed,
21 excluding the populations of established villages, incorporated
22 cities, unified municipalities, and organized boroughs that are wholly
23 or partly included within the radius;

24 (2) inside an established village, incorporated city, or
25 unified municipality if after the issuance or relocation there would
26 be inside the established village, incorporated city, or unified
27 municipality more than one restaurant or eating place license or club
28 license for each 1,500 population or fraction of 1,500 population or
29 more than one license of each other type, including licenses that have

1 been issued under (g) or (h) of this section, for each 3,000 popula-
2 tion or fraction of 3,000 population inside the established village,
3 incorporated city, or unified municipality;

4 (3) inside an organized borough but outside an established
5 village or incorporated city located within the borough, if after the
6 issuance or relocation there would be inside the borough, but outside
7 the established villages and incorporated cities located within the
8 borough, more than one restaurant or eating place license or club
9 license for each 1,500 population or fraction of 1,500 population or
10 more than one license of each other type, including licenses that have
11 been issued under (g) or (h) of this section, for each 3,000 popula-
12 tion or fraction of 3,000 population inside the borough, excluding the
13 population of those established villages that have conducted an elec-
14 tion on a question set out in AS 04.11.490, 04.11.496, or 04.11.500,
15 and excluding the population of incorporated cities located within the
16 organized borough.
