For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the addition of land to Shuyak

Island State Park, changes in Kodiak Island Borough

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. The commissioner of natural resources shall seek an amend-

13

ment to the Agreement of Settlement and Consent Decree of June 19, 1981,

14

between the state and the Kodiak Island Borough to

15

(1) make the following uplands that were retained by the state

under that agreement available to the Kodiak Island Borough under AS 29.-

17 Sections 5 - 9;

18 (5) require that borough relinquishments of land pursuant to the
19 Agreement of Settlement from Area I as amended in (4) of this section will
20 be made in a north to south direction in reasonably compact tracts that are
21 contiguous to state-owned land.

22 * Sec. 2. If the Agreement of Settlement and Consent Decree is amended
23 as proposed in sec. 1 of this Act, then the following land is added to
24 Shuyak Island State Park under AS 41.21.178:

25 (1) land relinquished by the borough under sec. 1(2) of this
26 Act;

27 (2) all state-owned or acquired land within the following de-
28 scribed area:

29 Township 18 South, Range 18 West, Seward Meridian

11 (3) state-owned or acquired land that was relinquished by the
12 borough under the provisions of sec. 2(b), ch. 167, SLA 1984, described as

16 Inlet
17 Section 34
18 Section 35: all land lying west of Carry Inlet
19 Township 19 South, Range 20 West, Seward Meridian

21 * Sec. 3. (a) The commissioner of natural resources shall identify and
22 offer for sale to the public 500 acres of state-owned land within the
23 Kodiak Island Borough under AS 38 by July 1, 1994.

24 (b) The land offered for sale under (a) of this section must be
25 reasonably accessible to the residents of the City of Kodiak and must be
26 land of good quality.

27 (c) The disposal of the land shall be held in the City of Kodiak.

28 (d) The commissioner of natural resources shall submit to the legis-
29 lature a report on the execution by the Department of Natural Resources of

1 the responsibility granted under (a) of this section. The report may not
2 be filed later than the 10th day of the First Regular Session of the Nine-
3 teenth Alaska State Legislature.

4 * Sec. 4. If the commissioner of natural resources does not report to
5 the legislature under sec. 3 of this Act that the Department of Natural
6 Resources has identified and offered for sale 500 acres of state-owned land
7 within the Kodiak Island Borough under AS 38 by July 1, 1994, sec. 2 of
8 this Act is repealed July 1, 1995.

9 * Sec. 5. This Act takes effect July 1, 1987.
