A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act making special appropriations for projects to
7 boost the Alaska economy; and providing for an effective
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. PURPOSE. The purpose of this appropriation Act is to
11 commit the expenditure of approximately \$75,000,000 from the state general
12 fund to a series of projects selected to put Alaskans throughout the state
13 to work. The projects were selected to:

- 14 (1) provide a worthwhile public purpose;
- 15 (2) provide immediate employment and begin significant expenditure
16 during calendar year 1988;
- 17 (3) be labor intensive; and
- 18 (4) ensure to the maximum extent possible the use of Alaskan
19 contractors or vendors.

20 * Sec. 2. IMPLEMENTATION. In the expenditure of the money appropriated
21 by this Act, agencies are to be guided by the state Administrative Manual,
22 with emphasis on the following requirements:

- 23 (1) there are to be separate solicitations (bids or requests for
24 proposals) for goods or professional services, to accommodate Alaskan
25 vendors if Alaskan vendors would otherwise not be able to respond;
- 26 (2) agency officials are to ensure that agency employees secure
27 quotations from Alaskan vendors to make small purchases;
- 28 (3) agencies are to specify products grown and manufactured in
29 Alaska when agencies seek wood products, food, or other materials;

1 additionally, agencies are to identify state and federal projects that
2 support the use of precast concrete made in Alaska; and
3 (4) at least 10 percent of evaluation points for proposals for
4 services should go to qualified Alaskan vendors.
