8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 04.06.090 is amended by adding a new subsection to

11 (f) If the board determines that it is necessary in order to
12 protect the public health, safety, or welfare, the board may act as a
13 licensee for purposes of holding and operating an existing package
14 store license. When the board acts as a licensee under this sub-
15 section, the board is subject to the requirements of this title as a
16 license holder and profits received from the operation of the package
17 store license shall be deposited quarterly into the general fund.
