A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to driver's licenses."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 28.15 is amended by adding a new section to read:

9 Sec. 28.15.105. MANDATORY DRIVING TEST. If the person applying
10 for a driver's license under AS 28.15.081 or for renewal of a driver's
11 license under AS 28.15.101 is more than 74 years of age, the
12 department shall require the person to demonstrate the ability to
13 exercise ordinary and reasonable control of a motor vehicle of the
14 type and class for which the person seeks a license. The department
15 shall require a person tested under this section to be retested every
16 two years, in order to maintain a valid driver's license in this
17 state.
