A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the termination date, members,
7 and reports of the Alaska Minerals Commission; and
8 providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. Section 2(b), ch. 98, SLA 1986, is amended to read:

11 (b) The commission is composed of 11 members. The commission
12 shall be composed of individuals who have at least five years' experi-
13 ence in the various aspects of the minerals industries in the state.
14 The governor shall appoint five members of the commission. The presi-
15 dent of the Senate shall appoint three members of the commission. The
16 speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint three members of
17 the commission. Each member serves at the pleasure of the appointing
18 authority.

19 * Sec. 2. Section 2(d), ch. 98, SLA 1986, is repealed and reenacted to
20 read:

21 (d) The commission shall report its recommendations each year to
22 the governor and the legislature during the first 10 days of the
23 regular session of the legislature.

24 * Sec. 3. Section 3, ch. 98, SLA 1986, is amended to read:

25 Sec. 3. This Act is repealed February 1, 1994 [1989].

26 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
