8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the practice of architecture is regulated in order to safe-
guard life, health, and property and to promote the public welfare; and

WHEREAS the Attorney General is responsible for enforcement of stat-
utes prohibiting the unauthorized practice of architecture; and

WHEREAS the wide range and extremes of climatic conditions found in
the state make it essential that only trained and qualified individuals be
allowed to design public and private buildings in the state; and

WHEREAS the unauthorized practice of architecture poses a serious risk
of personal injury and property damage;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests
the Governor to direct the Department of Law to allocate more resources to
enforcement of licensing requirements for architects and to vigorously
prosecute cases involving the unlawful practice of architecture.
