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SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 14

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FIFTEENTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

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Relating to the reconstruction and

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realignment of the Lazy Mountain/

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Wolverine Road in the Matanuska-Susitna

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Borough.

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BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

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WHEREAS the Lazy Mountain/Wolverine Road in the Matanuska-Susitna

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Borough is one of the oldest gravel roads in the borough; and

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WHEREAS the alignment of the road has not changed since it was con-

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structed from a cat trail in the late 1940's; and

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WHEREAS the pot holes, frost boils, ruts, and glaciation during the

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winter make the road dangerous to persons who use the road; and

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WHEREAS the road serves over 900 residents who live adjacent to the

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road and provides access to several farms; and

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WHEREAS the road serves as a school bus route four times each day;

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BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests

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the Governor to direct the Department of Transportation and Public Facil-

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ities to assign a high priority to the reconstruction and realignment of

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the Lazy Mountain/Wolverine Road in the Matanuska-Susitna Borough.
