6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS, for the fourth straight year, the United States has set aside

a week to focus attention on the nation's tourism industry; and

WHEREAS May 17 - 23, 1987, will be observed by the nation as National

10 Tourism Week; and

WHEREAS tourism is a vital part of the economy of the state; and

WHEREAS the state division of tourism is developing plans to observe

13 National Tourism Week; and

WHEREAS the observance of National Tourism Week by the state will

15 encourage the further development of the tourism industry in the state;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that May 17 - 23, 1987,

is designated National Tourism Week in the state, and state and local

government tourism agencies, members of the private tourism industry, and

other public and private agencies are encouraged to observe the week with
