4 FIFTEENTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION  
5 Encouraging the hiring of state resi-  
6 dents for state employment.  
7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:  
8 WHEREAS the rate of unemployment among residents of the state is one  
9 of the highest in the nation; and  
10 WHEREAS resident unemployment can lead to substantial social ills in  
11 the community; and  
12 WHEREAS the state is encouraging the federal government and private  
13 industry to employ state residents in preference to nonresidents for work  
14 performed in the state; and  
15 WHEREAS the state should set an example for other employers to follow;  
16 and  
17 WHEREAS the exempt service of the executive branch is designed for  
18 positions requiring the greatest degree of responsiveness to the policies  
19 and philosophies of the governor; and  
20 WHEREAS the partially exempt service is designed for positions that  
21 involve principal responsibility for the determination of policy or the way  
22 in which policies are implemented or which involve responsibilities and  
23 duties of a type not susceptible to the ordinary recruiting and examining  
24 procedures; and  
25 WHEREAS the state has more flexibility in hiring decisions for posi-  
26 tions in the exempt and partially exempt services than for positions in the  
27 classified service;  
28 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests  
29 the Governor to implement a policy of recruiting and hiring residents for

- 1 positions with state government, especially positions in the exempt and
- 2 partially exempt services of state employment.
