BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the state is experiencing a difficult economic period, and
10 many persons are finding it difficult to meet their financial obligations
11 and to improve their economic conditions; and

12 WHEREAS it would greatly help the state's economy if the state's
13 financial institutions would adjust their lending and collection policies
14 to the present abilities and needs of their customers by using more flexi-
15 ble approaches, such as collection moratoriums and flexible payment sched-
16 ules;

17 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature urges the financial
18 institutions of the state to adopt more flexible lending and collection
19 policies in order to help improve the economy of the state.
