7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS Don D. Statter was appointed the director of the division of
9 water and harbors in the Department of Public Works in 1966, a position he
10 retained until his retirement in 1982; and

11 WHEREAS during his tenure as director he established a statewide boat
12 harbor and port system; and

13 WHEREAS one of his major objectives as director was to build the best
14 possible harbor facilities for the least cost to the state; and

15 WHEREAS Don Statter was instrumental in laying the ground work to make
16 the Auke Bay Harbor Project possible; and

17 WHEREAS, after his retirement, Don continued to pursue his interest in
18 the development and operation of local harbors, ensuring adequate facili-
19 ties for the boating public by serving the public as a member of the Juneau
20 Harbor Board of Directors;

21 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Governor is
22 respectfully requested to direct the commissioner of transportation and
23 public facilities to name the state-owned facilities at Auke Bay Harbor,
24 including the transient moorage, boat harbor, and floating breakwater, the
25 Don D. Statter Harbor.
