7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
8 WHEREAS the idea for the Iditarod Sled Dog Race, the "Last Great Race
9 on Earth," was conceived in Wasilla by Joe Reddington, Sr., and Dorothy
10 Page; and
11 WHEREAS Wasilla is home of the headquarters of the Iditarod Trail
12 Committee, Inc. and the site of the race re-start; and
13 WHEREAS Wasilla desires to pay tribute to all the mushers who partici-
14 pate in the Iditarod Race and to share the great legacy of the Iditarod
15 with all the world; and
16 WHEREAS Wasilla desires to create year-round recognition of the race
17 through community identification, seasonal activities, and business pro-
18 motion; and
19 WHEREAS the Iditarod Trail Committee, the City of Wasilla, and the
20 local economy can benefit from mutual identification and support; and
21 WHEREAS the City of Wasilla adopted a resolution on March 30, 1988,
22 designating the city as "The Home of the Iditarod";
23 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the City of
24 Wasilla is recognized as "The Home of the Iditarod."
