Establishing a special committee on re-
source development.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

WHEREAS the state's economic future will continue to depend heavily on
its natural resources; and

9

10 WHEREAS the present economy of the state has been tied closely to
state spending of revenue derived from oil; and

11

12 WHEREAS dependency on oil revenue has resulted in an unstable economic
condition for the residents of the state; and

13

14 WHEREAS Alaska's other resources play important roles in stabilizing
and diversifying the state's economy; and

15

16 WHEREAS these resources are worthy of promotion, development, and
marketing; and

18 WHEREAS the state and municipal governments are interested in diversi-
fying the state's economy and reducing the state's dependence on revenue
derived solely from oil;

19

20 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate that a Senate Special Committee on Re-
source Development is established to examine other resource-related indus-
tries in light of the potential for furthering and enhancing economic
diversification; and be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED that the president of the Senate shall determine the
number of members of the Special Committee on Resource Development and
appoint the chair and members of the special committee; and be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED that the Special Committee on Resource Development
may meet during the session and during the interim after the Second Session

1 of the Fifteenth Legislature; and be it

2 **FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Special Committee on Resource Development
3 report its finding to the president of the Senate by January 1, 1989; and
4 be it

5 **FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Special Committee on Resource Development is
6 terminated on the convening of the Sixteenth Legislature.
