A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to credited service in the teachers'
7 retirement system for part-time teachers."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 14.25 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 14.25.109. PART-TIME TEACHERS. (a) A member who has been
11 employed in the system on a part-time basis may purchase additional
12 credited service. The amount purchased may not exceed an amount that
13 is sufficient, when added to the credited service the member received
14 for the part-time employment, to equal the credited service for full-
15 time employment for that period. The member may choose to use the
16 additional credited service to establish eligibility for benefits or
17 to compute the amount of benefits the member is entitled to receive,
18 or for both purposes.

19 (b) A member who elects to receive full-time credited service
20 for part-time service under (a) of this section is indebted to the
21 system in the amount of the full actuarial cost of benefits based on
22 the additional credited service. Interest as prescribed by regulation
23 accrues on the indebtedness beginning on the last day of each school
24 year in which the member has elected to purchase additional credited
25 service. An outstanding indebtedness that exists at the time the
26 member is appointed to retirement will require an actuarial adjustment
27 to the benefits that are based on the additional credited service
28 purchased under this section.

29 (c) To receive full-time credited service for part-time

1 employment during a school year under this section, the member must
2 claim the service on or before the later of June 30, 1990, or the date
3 one year after the last day of the school year in which the member was
4 employed part-time.
