6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to membership on the Recreation  
 7 Rivers Advisory Board."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 41.23.430(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) A 13-member [AN ELEVEN-MEMBER] Recreation Rivers Advisory  
 11 Board is established [AND SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR]. Board  
 12 members serve without compensation and are not entitled to per diem  
 13 and travel expenses authorized by law for boards and commissions under  
 14 AS 39.20.180. The governor shall appoint 11 members representing the  
 15 following user groups:

- 16 (1) commercial fishing;  
 17 (2) sport fishing;  
 18 (3) sport hunting;  
 19 (4) conservation;  
 20 (5) subsistence;  
 21 (6) forest products;  
 22 (7) mining;  
 23 (8) powerboat users;  
 24 (9) recreationally-oriented commercial users;  
 25 (10) other recreational users; and  
 26 (11) private property owners within the recreation river  
 27 corridor.

29 (c) The mayor of the Matanuska-Susitna Borough shall appoint two
